Certificate IV in Leadership and Management Pathway for Adults



Scouts Australia Institute of Training (SAIT) is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO 5443). The BSB42015 Certificate IV in Leadership and Management is a nationally recognised qualification which reflects the role of individuals working as emerging leaders and managers in a range of enterprise and industry contexts. As well as assuming responsibility for their own performance, individuals at this level provide leadership, guidance and support to others. They also have some responsibility for organising and monitoring the output of their team.

Typical Scouting pathway

Any member of Scouts Australia who has sufficient evidence can apply for Recognition of Prior Learning. Experiences and learning received by Leaders across Australia, has been mapped and aligns closely to the requirements of the Certificate IV in Leadership and Management. A typical pathway that enables collection of valid evidence for a Leader is:

- Complete the Basic training and be appointed as a Leader
- Complete e-Learning modules for Advanced training;
- Collect all PDF Attachments and other resources downloaded and used from e-Learning
- Complete the Advanced Practical Supplement course
- Be assessed as proficient for the awarding of a Wood Badge
